Facts About Our Education Center Debt

• Current minimum monthly payment \$11,433

• Loan maturity date 3/30/2026

 Amount of remaining interest to be paid through 6/01/22 assuming no additional principal payments \$30,108

What are the Needed Facility Repairs and Improvements?

Our campaign will also generate funds to address projected repairs/improvements to the LNMV Education Center over the next 3-10 years. Funds will be placed in a reserve account to use as the actual repairs take place.

Based on current condition and life expectancy, the specific future facility equipment repairs and improvements are:

- Twelve (12) roof top HVAC units
- Fire suppression control system
- Security system upgrades
- Septic/well system maintenance/repairs
- Generator maintenance
- Roof repairs and replacement
- Kitchen equipment may include maintenance, repair, or replacement of the freezer, cooler, compressors, stoves and dishwasher
- Carpeting
- Outside building grounds/maintenance
