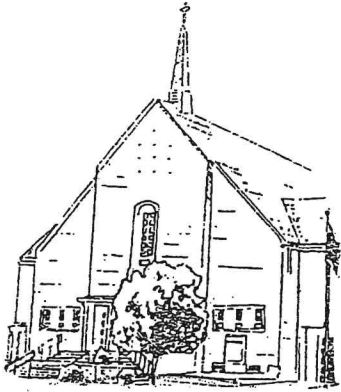

7 Christmas Carols that mean more to Pro-Lifers

There is a wonderful pro-life organization called 40 Days for Life, and on their weekly podcast this past Tuesday they did an episode about Christmas carols that have special meaning to the pro-life movement.

I'll list the seven songs they mention, but I encourage you to listen to the entire episode to learn why these songs are special for pro-lifers. In addition, the three hosts of the podcast do Christmas trivia, discuss Christmas movies, and most importantly, discuss the importance of Christmas songs, all in a spirit of lots of playful banter between them.

To find the podcast, just search online or in a podcast app for "40 Days for Life Podcast" and find the episode titled "7 Christmas Carols that mean more to pro-lifers".

Here are the 7 songs they highlight as being extra special to pro-lifers:

- † O come o come Emmanuel
- † What child is this
- † I heard the bells on Christmas day
- † It came upon a midnight clear
- † O holy night
- † O come all ye faithful
- † Joy to the world

In this podcast you'll not only learn more about these songs, but you will also learn about verses to the songs that you may have never heard before, but which have profound meaning.

Here is one neat piece of trivia that they mention in the podcast... Did you know that Mariah Carey was dubbed the "Queen of Christmas", but that in an interview she stated: "I just want to humbly say that I don't consider myself [the queen of Christmas]. To me, Mary is the Queen of Christmas." She explained that she loves the Christmas season and singing Christmas music, but her faith proclaims that Mary is the true Queen of Christmas.

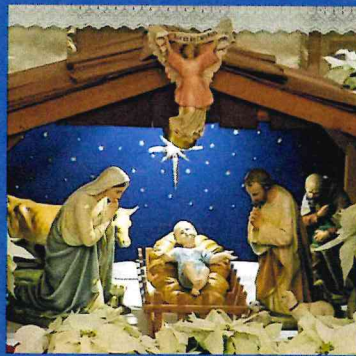

End of Year Planned Giving

When you make a planned gift that supports The Church of the Immaculate Conception, you ensure that the mission of our parish is fulfilled. Your planned gift has a lasting impact on our Church and on our world.

Gift of Stock

A gift of stock to the Church of the Immaculate Conception can provide you with DOUBLE TAX BENEFITS. First, you may be able to claim a charitable donation in the amount of the market value of the stock (original cost plus any increase in value) on the date the gift is made to the Church of the Immaculate Conception. Second, you avoid paying taxes on the appreciated value of the donated stock.

IRA Direct Transfer


If you make a direct transfer from your IRA to the Church of the Immaculate Conception this won't increase your adjusted gross income as this transfer is not actually distributed to you. This is called a Qualified Charitable Distribution. This option is particularly beneficial if you don't itemize deductions on your tax return.

Matching Donation

Many employers sponsor matching gift programs and will match any charitable contributions made by their employees to a qualified charitable organization. Most employers will match to the school and some employers will match to the Church as well. This is a way to double your gift to benefit the Church of the Immaculate Conception.




