

Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

On January 1st, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, I announced that as we celebrate the year 2025, a quarter century, I would like this to be a special year for our parish to dedicate ourselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. I'd like to explain more details about my plan.

By consecrating ourselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we are making an intentional act of trust in Jesus and asking him to be with us and help us.

I have a special family consecration book that I bought for all the families of our parish with children that I will be handing out. I will also be sending out a digital copy of this consecration book to all parishioners via email, so everyone can participate. This family consecration consists of 33 days of short prayers and activities to do as a family as a way of focusing on the Sacred Heart of Jesus. I was very impressed with the daily 1-page readings they have, and the prayers and activities they recommend to do as a family.

This family consecration may be done anytime during 2025. The feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus this year falls on Friday, June 27th. Therefore, counting back 33 days as the preparation time, I recommend that everyone consider starting the family consecration on Monday, May 26th. This way you will finish just in time to celebrate the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and can make your official family consecration on that day. However, if you prefer to start sooner or later that is just fine too.



I also encourage all families this year to purchase a large image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to prominently display in your home. In the coming weeks I will be highlighting different images of the Sacred Heart here in the bulletin so you can become familiar with several wonderful versions of the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.






