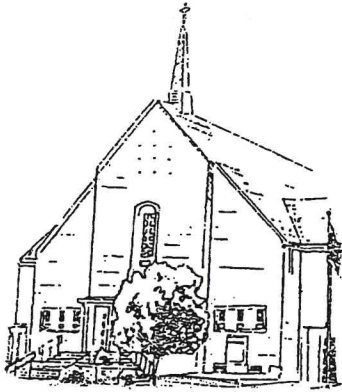

## Magisterium AI

Artificial Intelligence is becoming more and more used in our world today. I do have some concern about how it could be misused, or how it could affect us socially and educationally. Nevertheless, AI also has some very positive qualities. One of the greatest benefits is how you can ask AI a question and it is able to summarize a lot of information into a short and simple answer within seconds. This can be a very useful tool for learning.

I recently came across a new tool built on AI to help understand our Catholic faith better. The website is called Magisterium AI - <https://www.magisterium.com/>

On this site, you can type in any question about the Catholic faith, and it will give you an answer summarizing what we believe. It can also do other helpful things, for example, the website suggests trying typing in:

- Tell me about the saints of the day
- Write me a children's story about the parable of the good Samaritan

Other ways this website can be used:

**Explanation of Concepts:** Magisterium AI can help explain complex theological, philosophical, and historical concepts in simple, understandable language. This includes explaining key teachings of the Church, such as the Trinity, the Incarnation, the Sacraments, and others.

**Answering Questions:** Users can ask Magisterium AI any questions they might have about the Church's teachings, practices, or other topics. The model can provide detailed answers based on the knowledge it has access to.

**Contextual Information:** The Catholic Church has a long and complex history, which is often deeply intertwined with the development of Western civilization. Magisterium AI can provide contextual information about this history, which can help users understand why the Church teaches what it does.

**Resource Recommendations:** Magisterium AI can recommend books, documents, and other resources that can provide further information on topics of interest.

**Practice Conversations:** Users who are studying to join the Church or prepare for sacraments like Baptism or Confirmation could use Magisterium AI to simulate conversations they might have with clergy or other members of the Church.

**Clarifying Complex Concepts:** The complex doctrines and theological concepts in Catholicism can sometimes be hard to understand. Magisterium AI can help to simplify and explain these in layman's terms, making them more accessible.

The website also includes this important note: "It's important to remember, however, that while Magisterium AI can provide valuable information and context, it should not be the sole resource for someone trying to understand Catholic teachings. It's always good to consult authoritative sources, engage in discussion with knowledgeable individuals and leaders of the Church, and read primary sources like the Catechism of the Catholic Church."

I have asked Magisterium AI a few questions and have been very impressed by its answers. For example, I have tried:

- Explain purgatory to me
- Explain purgatory to a child in one sentence
- How do you answer a young child who asks: "Who made God?"?
- Why is St. Thomas Aquinas important?

I encourage you to check out Magisterium AI and give it a try!

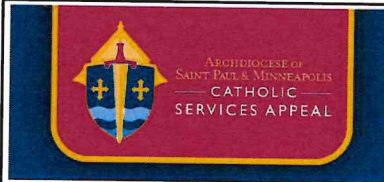

## Daily Mass Seating Change

Beginning this Tuesday, for daily Masses, I ask that everyone sit in the front of church. To help facilitate this, the back pews in church will be roped off. The reason for this is that when we celebrate Mass we are united as a community of believers. However, too often, it seems more like a few scattered individuals who sit as far away from each other and the altar as they can. This has made it very difficult for me to celebrate daily Masses well. Therefore, we are going to try out having everyone sit together in the front of church.

Many churches use a smaller chapel for daily Mass because of this exact situation, however, since we do not have a smaller chapel, we will just make the church smaller so that we can be more together as a community of faith.

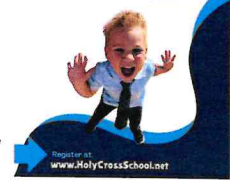

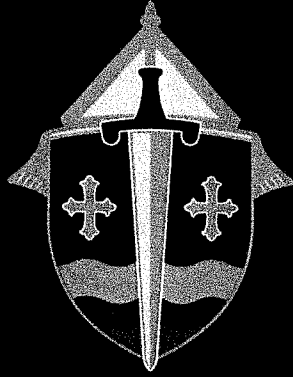

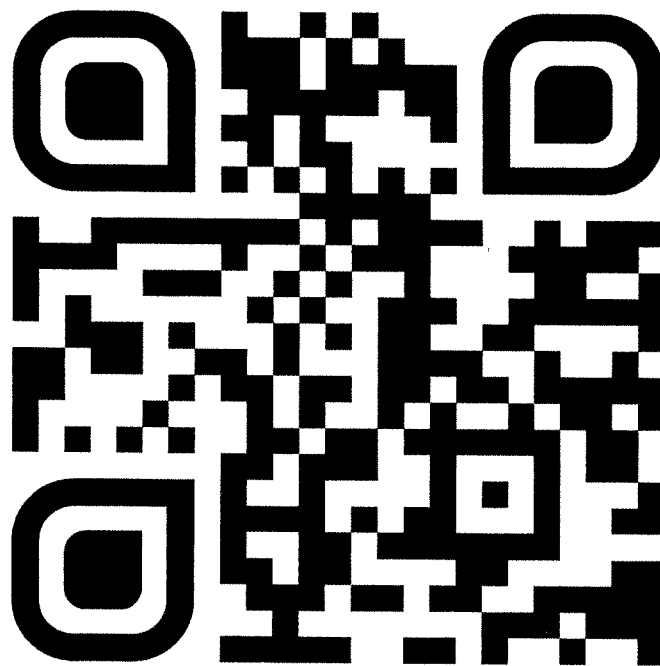
