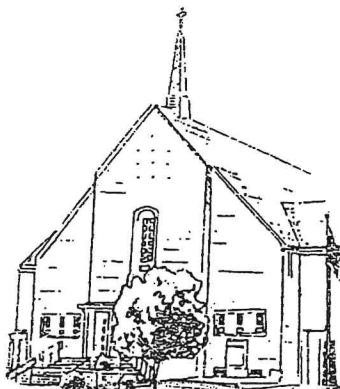

St. Joseph

March 19th is the Solemnity of St. Joseph. St. Joseph is a very important and special saint. He was chosen by God to become the spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the adoptive father of Jesus on earth. He has been given the title of Patron of the Universal Church for his protection he shows us, just as he protected and led the Holy Family.

St. Joseph is the model especially for all Christian fathers. He shows us many virtues that we should foster in our lives and in our families. I want to encourage everyone to grow in your knowledge and devotion to St. Joseph. There is a tradition to especially honor St. Joseph on Wednesdays, and am trying to begin to be more intentional about praying to him weekly on that day.

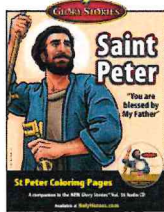

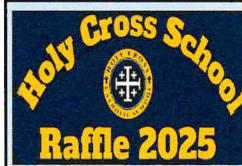

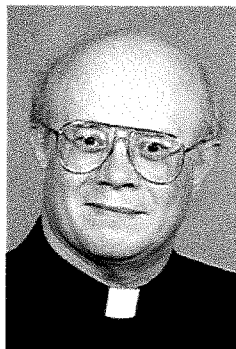

Fr. Arnold “Michael” Sauber

July 13, 1943 – March 11, 2025



Father A. Michael Sauber, age 81 of St. Paul, formerly of Lakeville, MN, passed away peacefully on March 11, 2025. Born Arnold Michael Sauber to Arnold and Ethel (Schmitz) Sauber on July 13, 1943, in Farmington, MN, Michael went to school in Lakeville until he entered the St. Paul/Minneapolis Archdiocesan St. Paul Seminary system. He was ordained a Catholic Priest on May 24, 1969. He also attended University of St. Thomas and received his master's degree.

He served in several Archdiocesan parishes: St. Joseph in West St. Paul, St. Agnes in St. Paul, again at St. Joseph in West St. Paul, St. Luke in Clearwater, St. Mary in Shakopee, Immaculate Conception in Lonsdale, and St. Olaf in Minneapolis. Fr. Sauber also served as Rural Life Director for the Archdiocese for about 10 years.

Father Michael is preceded in death by his parents, Arnold and Ethel, and brother-in-law, Donald Thomas. He is survived by his siblings, Jerome (Janet) Sauber, Elizabeth Thomas, Nancy (Tim Kuntz) Sauber, Colleen Sauber, and William (Cindy) Sauber, and also by many nieces and nephews.
