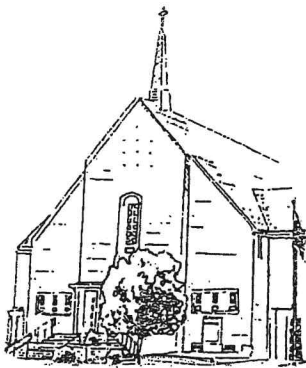

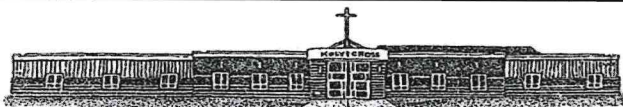

# December 28, 2025

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

*"Rise, take the child and his mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I tell you.  
Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him."*

## The Christmas Crèche

The word crèche means manger or crib, and refers to the Nativity Scene  
that we setup for Christmas to honor Jesus' birth.

St. Francis of Assisi is attributed as having setup the first Christmas  
crèche in the year 1233. St. Bonaventure wrote this about St. Francis:  
"The man of God, filled with tender love, stood before the manger,  
bathed in tears, and overflowing with joy."

Setting up the Christmas Crèche is a wonderful tradition that has been  
handed down to us, and not only does every Catholic Church in the  
world now display a Christmas Crèche, but most Catholic households do  
as well, either inside their home or outside or both. Growing up, setting  
up the Nativity Scene was always a great highlight for us as kids as we  
prepared for Christmas.

Here at Immaculate Conception, we have two beautiful Crèches – one  
inside the church and one outside. You will notice that this year we  
moved the location of the Crèche inside the church. I decided to do this  
to respect the liturgical guidelines regarding the location of the Crèche.

The Book of Blessings states: "If the manger is set up in the church, it  
must not be placed in the presbyterium [sanctuary]. A place should be  
chosen that is suitable for prayer and devotion and is easily accessible  
by the faithful."

In past years, the Crèche has been placed directly in front of the altar,  
making it the most prominent thing in the sanctuary. However, even  
though the Christmas Crèche is a beautiful tradition, it is an object of  
devotion and not something that is part of the Mass itself, that is why it  
should not distract from the focus of the Mass and the centrality of the  
altar. This is why the Church asks us not to setup the Crèche in the  
sanctuary. The new location is still very prominent, but does not take the  
attention away from the altar.

Finally, just a reminder that the 12 days of Christmas aren't the days  
leading up to Christmas, but rather begin on Christmas day. The  
Christmas season used to go exactly 12 days – from December 25<sup>th</sup> to  
January 6<sup>th</sup> – when the feast of the Epiphany of the Lord was always  
celebrated on January 6<sup>th</sup>. Now, however, the feast of the Epiphany is  
celebrated on the Sunday after January 1<sup>st</sup>, and the season of Christmas  
usually goes another full week to the feast of the Baptism of the Lord,  
which is usually the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday after January 1<sup>st</sup> (this year it is on  
January 11<sup>th</sup>). I encourage you to keep your Christmas decorations and  
lights up and lit for the full Christmas season!

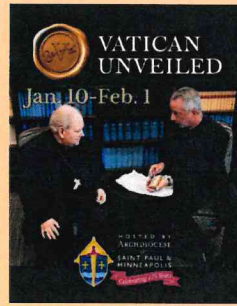
### December Prayer Intention of the Holy Father

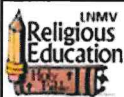

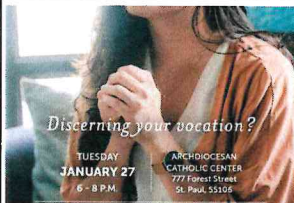

## END OF YEAR PLANNED GIVING

When you make a planned gift that supports The Church of the Immaculate Conception, you ensure that the mission of our parish is fulfilled. Your planned gift has a lasting impact on our Church and on our world.

### Gift of Stock

A gift of stock to the Church of the Immaculate Conception can provide you with DOUBLE TAX BENEFITS. First, you may be able to claim a charitable donation in the amount of the market value of the stock (original cost plus any increase in value) on the date the gift is made to the Church of the Immaculate Conception. Second, you avoid paying taxes on the appreciated value of the donated stock.

### IRA Direct Transfer

If you make a direct transfer from your IRA to the Church of the Immaculate Conception, this won't increase your adjusted gross income as this transfer is not actually distributed to you. This is called a Qualified Charitable Distribution. This option is particularly beneficial if you don't itemize deductions on your tax return.

### Matching Donation

Many employers sponsor matching gift programs and will match any charitable contributions made by their employees to a qualified charitable organization. Most employers will match to the school and some employers will match to the Church as well. This is a way to double your gift to benefit the Church of the Immaculate Conception.
