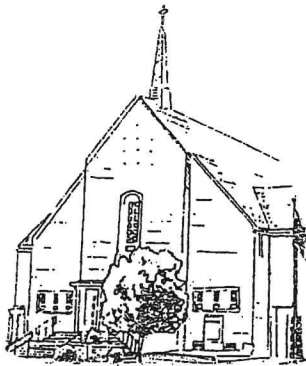

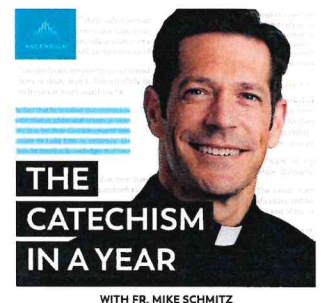
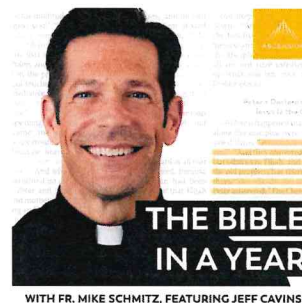

Bible in a Year and Catechism in a Year Podcasts

Many of you have told me that you have already listened to Fr. Mike Schmitz's Bible in a Year and Catechism in a Year podcasts, and that is wonderful to hear!



If you have not yet listened to one or both of these podcasts, I really encourage you to start listening to one of them today to follow them through this new year.

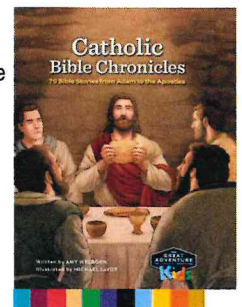
Although the podcasts were recorded a few years ago, you can still pull them up and start listening to them at the beginning, and to go at your own pace.

I would estimate that very few Catholics will ever read the Bible cover to cover, or the Catechism of the Catholic Church cover to cover. These podcasts by Fr. Mike are an amazing opportunity to have the bible and catechism read to you! Over the course of 365 days, Fr. Mike read and explains the entire bible and catechism. His reflections are excellent, relatable, and very helpful in learning our faith at a much deeper level.

I highly encourage all Catholics to listen to these podcasts. You will learn so much about our faith – what we believe and why we believe it.

And for kids, there is a podcast called "Kid's Bible in a Year with Teddy" the I would encourage you to lookup as well.

Teddy Howell is a child living in Michigan who decided to record a kid-friendly version of the Bible in a Year. After an opening prayer, Teddy reads a story from the Great Adventure Kid's Catholic Bible Chronicles.



If you have kids, I encourage you to listen to this with them. You can find Bible in a Year, Catechism in a Year, and the Kid's Bible in a Year with Teddy podcasts through any podcast app, or by searching online.

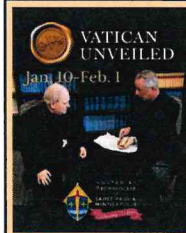

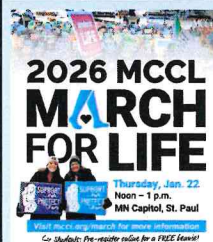

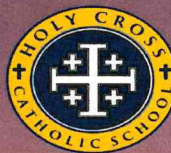
