


250 Rosaries for the 250th Anniversary of our Nation

This coming July 4th will be the 250th Anniversary of the Declaration of Independence, in which we celebrate the birthday of the United States of America.

As we prepare to celebrate this great milestone for our country, I want to encourage you to also pray for our country.

Someone came up with the idea of each parish praying 250 rosaries for our country. I love this idea, and so I would like to encourage all of you to pray a rosary for our country for the intention of putting our country under the protective mantle of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

To help facilitate all 250 rosaries, I have put in the back of church a poster titled "250 Rosaries for the 250th Anniversary of our Nation". The poster has 250 stars on it. Thus, when you complete a rosary for our country, please place a star sticker over one of the stars on the poster. This way we will keep track and make sure we pray all 250 rosaries.



However, for a rosary to qualify as a star sticker, it must be in addition to your daily rosary. i.e. it should be a second rosary that you pray that day, or if you generally do not pray the rosary, then a rosary you intentionally pray for our country.

Thank you for your participation in this wonderful spiritual work of mercy.





For our Lenten coloring contest this year, we are excited to highlight the apparition of Our Lady of Champion in Wisconsin, and the Marian visionary, Adelle Brice, who was recently named a Servant of God. We will be pulling pages from a Holy Heroes coloring book about Our Lady of Champion, and the life story of Adele Brice. Each week we will publish part of the story that relates to the coloring page.

Starting the first Sunday of Lent for 5 weeks, we will have the coloring page for the week ready for pickup in the back of church. AND... Each week, if you color the page and bring it back the following week, you can be entered into that week's contest.

The topic for week #1's coloring page:

The Seer

Adele Brice (Brise) was born in Belgium to Lambert and Catherine Brice on January 30, 1831. Although she suffered an accident at a young age that left her blind in her right eye, those who knew her best describe her cheerfulness, fervent piety, and simple religious ways.


Upon receiving her first Holy Communion, Adele and a few close friends promised the Blessed Virgin Mary that they would devote their lives to becoming religious teaching sisters in Belgium. However, this promise grew difficult to keep when her parents decided to move to America alongside other Belgium settlers. After seeking advice from her confessor, she was told to be obedient to her parents. He assured her that if the Lord willed her to become a teacher and a sister, she would serve in that vocation in America.

After the six-week voyage to America, the Brice family joined the largest Belgian settlement - near present-day Champion, Wisconsin. Belgian pioneers' and settlers' lives were difficult, and many died in the harsh Wisconsin winters. Adele served her family's needs by often taking grain to the grist mill.
