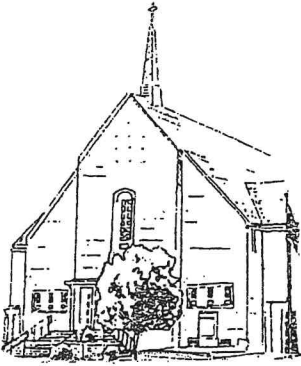

3rd Sunday of Easter

Lord Jesus, open the Scriptures to us;  
make our hearts burn while you speak to us.

## The Precepts of the Church

Last weekend I began a new homily series on the Precepts of the Church. Over the next several weeks I will be addressing them one at a time.

The Precepts of the Church are certain things that are required of us as Catholics. They are based on biblical principals, and the Church has clarified how we are to live out these biblical principals in our lives.

Since the Catholic Church is established by Christ to speak and act in his name, the Church has the authority to prescribe specific actions that we, as members of the Church, must follow. This is why they are called the "precepts" of the Church.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Jesus entrusted a specific authority to Peter: "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." The "power of the keys" designates authority to govern the house of God, which is the Church. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, confirmed this mandate after his Resurrection: "Feed my sheep." The power to "bind and loose" connotes the authority to absolve sins, to pronounce doctrinal judgments, and to make disciplinary decisions in the Church. Jesus entrusted this authority to the Church through the ministry of the apostles and in particular through the ministry of Peter, the only one to whom he specifically entrusted the keys of the kingdom." (CCC 553)

The Precepts are specifically address in the Catechism in paragraphs 2041 – 2043.

"The precepts of the Church are set in the context of a moral life bound to and nourished by liturgical life. The obligatory character of these positive laws decreed by the pastoral authorities is meant to guarantee to the faithful the very necessary minimum in the spirit of prayer and moral effort, in the growth in love of God and neighbor." (CCC 2041)

i.e. The Precepts of the Church are for the good of our souls. And we are bound to obey the Precepts of the Church under pain of sin.

The 7 Precepts of the Church are:

1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor.
2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
3. You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.
4. You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
5. You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.
6. You shall obey the laws of the Church concerning Matrimony.
7. You shall participate in the Church's mission of Evangelization of Souls.

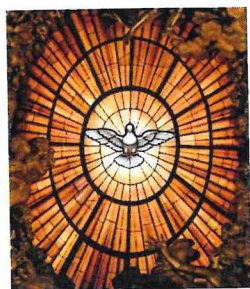

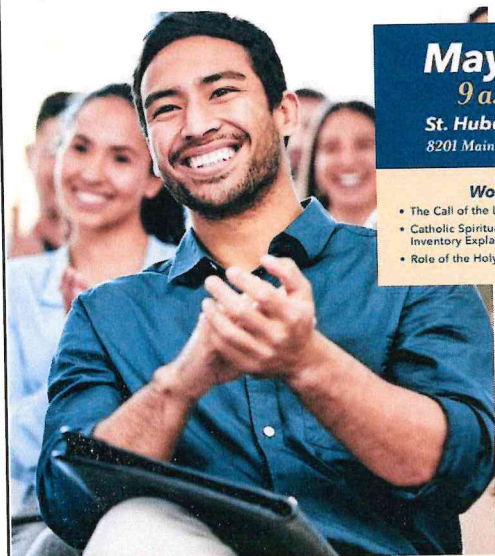

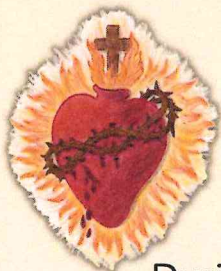
