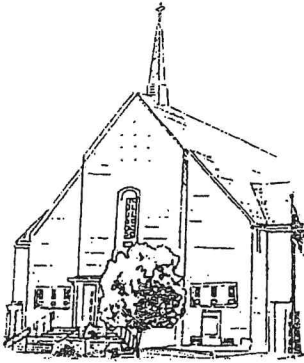

Thank you, Dad

Today we celebrate Father's Day. It is an important day to thank our fathers for their love and leadership of our families.

PragerU just published a new video titled "Thank you, Dad", that I encourage you all to look up and watch. It is a wonderful video honoring some of the ways a dad can have a powerful influence in the life of his family. Things like teaching his children perseverance and dedication and working hard, protecting and defending women, being a leader in sports and in the world, and being a man of prayer. It shows the powerful influence a good man can have on his family and on the world.

I want to thank and honor my own father who taught me to work hard, to be responsible, to not take shortcuts because they are easier or faster, and to be dedicated to God. He taught me to hunt and fish and fix things and build things. I am the man I am today largely because of my dad. Thank you, Dad.

God made men to protect, provide, and lead. It is built into a man to desire to do those things.

Why do so many boys like to play army men, or sword fight, or cowboys and Indians? Because we want to be strong, we want to be brave, we want to conquer and to protect. God made men this way because we need good men to be strong and brave and to protect others.

And some men do have to protect their family, or fight in a war. But most of the time, we aren't called to heroic moments like that. But we are daily called to faithful service of others, especially your family.

Every man is called to protect, provide for, and lead his family in virtue and faith. That doesn't seem nearly as heroic as fighting an intruder. But it is just as important. Because if you protect your family from a bad guy breaking in, but you do not protect your family from sin, then you are only protecting their bodies but not their souls.

We need men who protect, provide, and lead the souls of their wife and children.

If God made men the head of their household, it is in no way for his own sake. Rather, God made men the head of the household because God intends him to be the leader in serving his family and protecting them and leading them in virtue. The authority that God gave men is never to be used for his own sake over and against his wife or children. His authority is to be used to lead the family in what is best for them.

Men, tell your wife daily that you still choose her. Tell her you love her. And tell her you still find her beautiful. She needs to hear this from you.

And affirm your children. Tell them you love them, and that you're proud of them. They need to hear that from their dad.

And to wives: Tell your husbands that you are proud of them, that you admire them, and you are grateful for their hard work for the sake of providing for your family. Ladies, you are the #1 person your husband wants to please, and so for you to tell him how much you respect him and how grateful you are for him means more to him than anything.

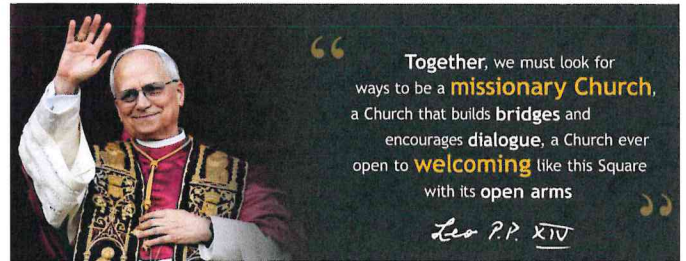

Interested in elevating your summer reading? Curious about how fiction can bring you closer to God?

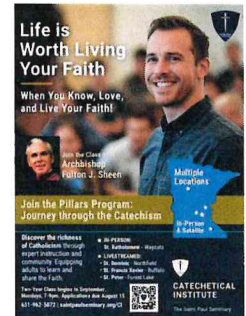

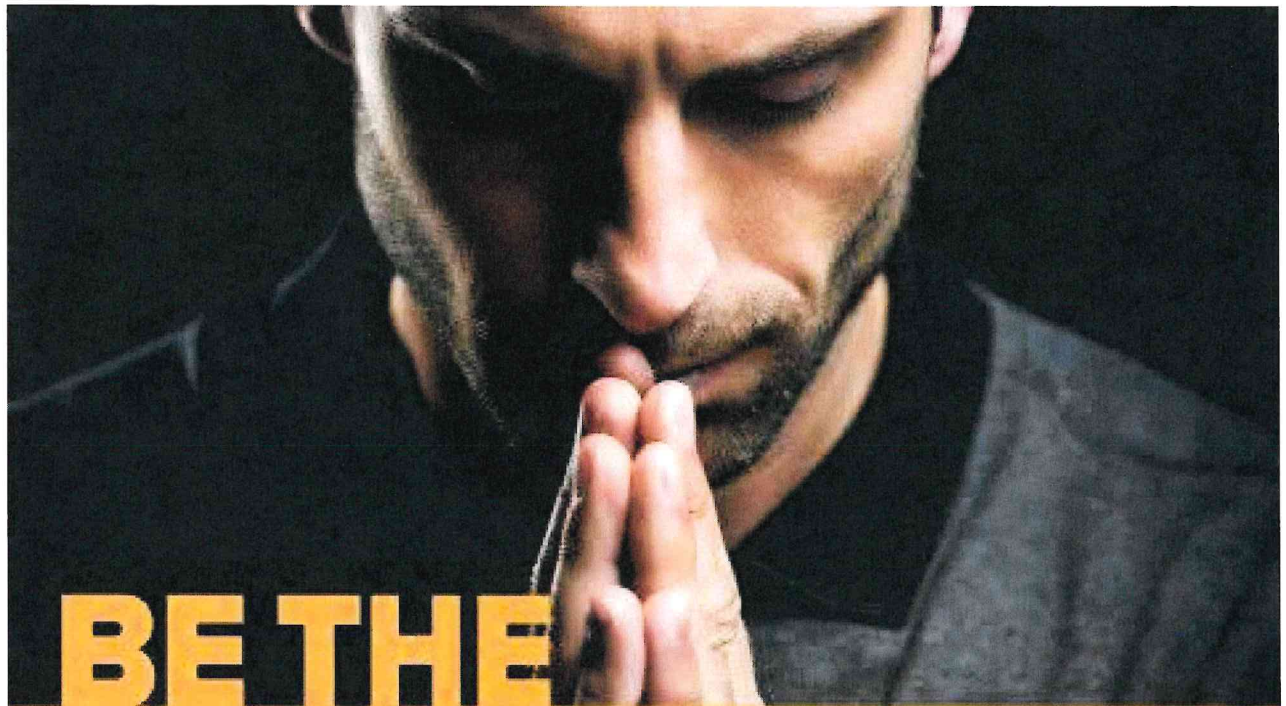

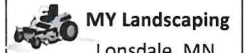
