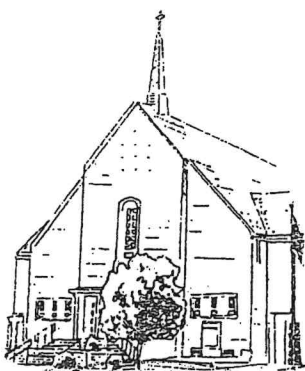

"Whoever has ears ought to hear."

The Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel

In the 13th Century, Mary appeared to St. Simon Stock on Mount Carmel in the land of Israel. Mount Carmel is a special biblical location where the prophet Elijah went to listen to the voice of God. As Mary appeared to St. Simon Stock, she appeared holding the child Jesus in one hand and the brown scapular in the other. She promised that anyone who would die wearing the brown scapular would be saved.

The scapular is made of cloth and is symbolic of our being clothed by Mary, with her mantle and protection. The popular scapular worn by the faithful is a smaller version of the scapular worn as part of the habit of men and women religious. The scapular is a visible symbol that we have committed ourselves to Mary's honor, and entrusted ourselves to her protection.

The brown scapular is a wonderful devotion to our Blessed Mother, and I highly recommend everyone to wear a scapular.

There is an official rite of enrollment to begin wearing the scapular. If you have not been enrolled, and would like to be, I invite you to talk to me. Once enrolled, you need not have future scapulars blessed before wearing them, because you have been permanently enrolled to wear this little habit of the Blessed Virgin.

We just celebrated the feast day of Our Lady of Mount Carmel on July 16th, so now is the perfect time to get a scapular and to be enrolled!

Here are some excerpts from the Rite of Enrollment:

Lord Jesus Christ, Savior of the human race, sanctify by Your power these scapulars, which for love of You and for love of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Your servants will wear devoutly, so that through the intercession of the same Virgin Mary, Mother of God, and protected against the evil spirit, they may persevere until death in Your grace. You who live and reign world without end. Amen.

Receive this blessed Scapular and ask the Most Holy Virgin that by her merits, it may be worn with no stain of sin, protect you from all harm, and bring you to everlasting life.

May God Almighty, the Creator of heaven and earth, bless you, He who has deigned to join you to the confraternity of the Blessed Virgin of Mount Carmel; we beseech her to crush the head of the ancient serpent so that you may enter into possession of your eternal heritage through Christ our Lord. Amen.

End of fiscal year financial update

Our fiscal year runs from July 1st to June 30th, so you will notice in today's bulletin that our annual budget and income for Sunday giving have been reset.

Our last bulletin indicated that as of June 28th, 2026, we had budgeted \$295,003, and had collected \$278,373, which left us with a deficit of \$16,630. That is quite a bit short of our budget, which means Sunday collections were not nearly as strong as we had expected or hoped. However, on the positive side, we were able to have less parish expenses than budgeted, so we still finished the fiscal year in the black.

That being said, I'd like to encourage you to please continue to be generous in supporting the church through your Sunday giving, which is our main source of income. Thank you for your generosity!

As an additional note, we have heard that our envelope company has fallen way behind and so they will not be shipping envelopes for July. We apologize for that. But please continue your contributions! If you donate by check or put cash in an envelope with your name on it, we will still be able to attribute the contribution to you.
