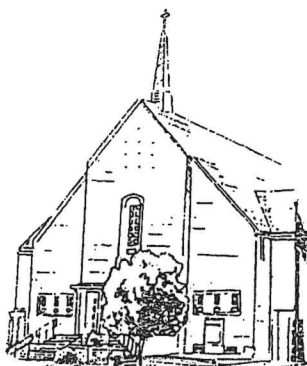

How to offer each decade of the Rosary – The Joyful Mysteries

I recently read a great book by St. Louis de Montfort called The Secret of the Rosary, which is a series of meditations and stories about how powerful the rosary is. There is also a section in the book about how to think about and offer each decade of the rosary. I'd like to share this part for your reflection and use.

Simply pray these short prayers before the appropriate decade of the rosary that you are saying, and try to keep your mind and heart focused on this intention for the entire decade.

## **The Joyful Mysteries**

First Decade (The Annunciation) – We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honor of your Incarnation and we ask of you, through this mystery and through the intercession of your most Holy Mother, a profound humility.

Second Decade (The Visitation) – We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honor of the Visitation of your Holy Mother to her cousin Saint Elizabeth, and we ask of you through this mystery and through Mary's intercession, a perfect charity towards our neighbor.

Third Decade (The Nativity) – We offer you, O Child Jesus, this decade in honor of your Blessed Nativity, and we ask of you, through this mystery and through the intercession of your Blessed Mother, detachment from things of this world, love of poverty and love of the poor.

Fourth Decade (The Presentation in the Temple) – We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honor of your Presentation in the temple by the hands of Mary, and we ask of you, through this mystery and through the intercession of your Blessed Mother, the gift of wisdom and purity of heart and body.

Fifth Decade (The Finding in the Temple) – We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honor of your Finding in the Temple among the learned men by Our Lady, after she had lost you, and we ask you, through this mystery and through the intercession of your Blessed Mother, to convert us and help us amend our lives, and also to convert all sinners, heretics, schismatics and idolaters.

### **Closing prayer:**

We beseech you, dear Lord Jesus, by the mysteries of your life, death and passion by your glory and by the merits of your Blessed Mother, to convert sinners and help the dying, to deliver the Holy Souls from purgatory and to give us all your grace so that we may live well and die well—and please give us the Light of your glory later on so that we may see you face to face and love you for all eternity. Amen.

End of fiscal year financial update

Our fiscal year runs from July 1st to June 30th, so you will notice in today's bulletin that our annual budget and income for Sunday giving have been reset. Our last bulletin indicated that as of June 28th, 2026, we had budgeted \$295,003, and had collected \$278,373, which left us with a deficit of \$16,630. That is quite a bit short of our budget, which means Sunday collections were not nearly as strong as we had expected or hoped. However, on the positive side, we were able to have less parish expenses than budgeted, so we still finished the fiscal year in the black.

That being said, I'd like to encourage you to please continue to be generous in supporting the church through your Sunday giving, which is our main source of income. Thank you for your generosity!

As an additional note, we have heard that our envelope company has fallen away behind and so they will not be shipping envelopes for July. We apologize for that. But please continue your contributions! If you donate by check or put cash in an envelope with your name on it, we will still be able to attribute the contribution to you.

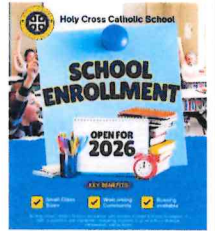

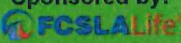
