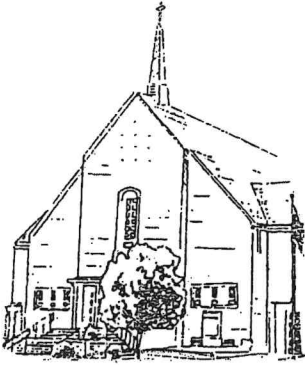

Seminarian: Jackson Simon

It is with great joy and pride that our parish will have its first
seminarian in 46 years! Jackson Simon is entering St. John
Vianney College Seminary this weekend to begin discerning a
call to the priesthood.

Our last seminarian was Fr. Michael Skluzacek, who was
ordained in 1980.

Jackson is the son of Paul & Cassy Simon, and is 20 years old.
He went to Holy Cross Catholic School through 8th grade, and
Bethlehem Academy for high school. He has taken some
college classes at the University of Mary in Bismark, and also at
Dakota County Technical College.

A good sign of a healthy and flourishing parish is that it
produces religious vocations. So it is a great encouragement to
me for us to have a young man from our community discerning
the priesthood.

The seminary has a twofold purpose. One is to help the
seminarian discern if God is truly calling him to the priesthood.
And the second is to begin preparing him for this vocation.

The seminary achieves these goals through four main "pillars of
formation", or ways that a man is formed to become a priest.
They are: spiritual, human, intellectual, and pastoral. Spiritual
formation helps him to develop his prayer life and union with
God. Human formation helps him grow in virtue and avoid sin.
Intellectual formation helps him grow in knowledge. And
pastoral formation helps him in learning how to minister to
others. Each of these four pillars is essential to forming a good
priest.

College seminary can also be expensive. St. John Vianney
College Seminary is at the University of St. Thomas and that is
where the seminarians take most of their classes. The
Archdiocese pays for room and board, but the college tuition is
left up to the seminarian to pay for himself. I therefore
encourage you to consider making a donation to Jackson to
assist him in paying for his schooling. To do so, please contact
the Simon family directly, or bring a check or cash to the parish
office in an envelope with his name on it, and write checks
directly to Jackson. Thank you for your support.

I encourage you to pray daily for an increase in vocations to the
priesthood, and especially to keep Jackson in your prayers.

You are in my daily prayers too.

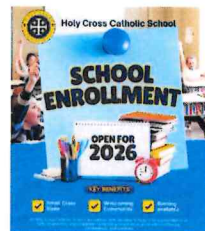
